The President informed the members that the Governor was considering removal of 501C, tax exempt status. It was agreed that Insurance was our greatest expense and that Picnic Raffle and auction bring in needed funds. Don KB2VMR said that money collected at the Ham Jam was donated to the Club.

Motion was made to adjourn the meeting by Fred KC2KBQ and Seconded by Ron KC2JGP at 8:16 PM.
