Draft of Bylaw change #1, initially submitted 9/14/09

I hereby propose the following change to the bylaws of the Jefferson County Radio Amateur Club, Inc.

I propose the insertion of a paragraph allowing three additional levels of “supporting donor” membership. Included below is the suggested wording of this new paragraph.

Paragraph 2 (d)

“Supporting Donor Membership is available to community leaders and businesses through either monetary or in-kind donation to the club. The three tiers of supporting donor membership shall be bronze (\$1000), silver (\$2500) and gold (\$5000 or greater) and shall be recognized by issuance of a framed membership certificate in recognition of their support. Supporting Donor Membership does not confer the right to vote or hold office.”

Draft of Bylaw change #2, initially submitted 9/14/09

I hereby propose the following change to the bylaws of the Jefferson County Radio Amateur Club, Inc.

I propose the addition of a ninth bylaw for handling of donations to the club. Included below is the suggested wording of this new paragraph.

9. Donations

“No member shall accept a donation on behalf of the club valued at \$200 (two hundred dollars) or greater without first submitting request to the Treasurer for a donation receipt. Donation receipts shall be provided to all donors providing a monetary or in-kind donation with a value of over \$200 (two hundred dollars) and by request for lesser amounts.

Any item donated to the club with a value of greater than \$200 may not be sold or donated to a third party within two years of its date of donation unless:

- A) The item was donated to the club for such a purpose. (Example: Raffle / Auction Items)
- B) The original donor is provided the opportunity of first bid on the sale of such item.”
